DESCRIPTION:

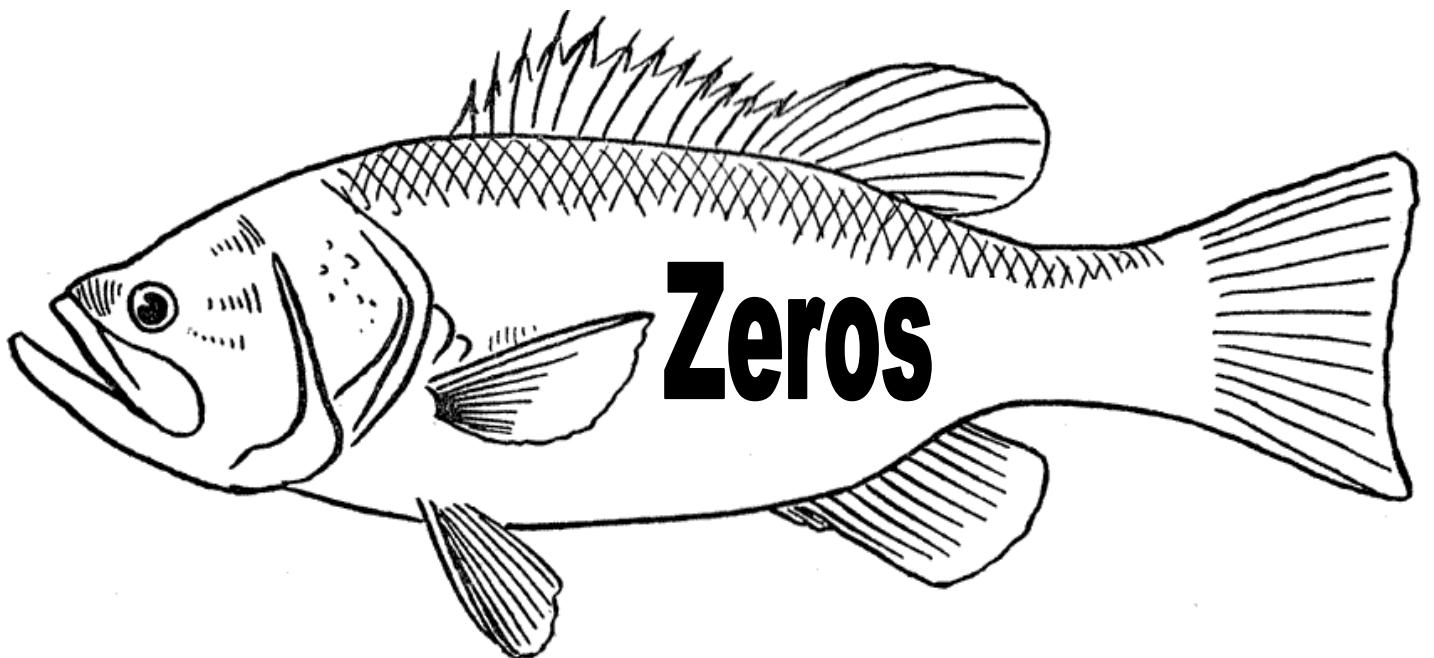
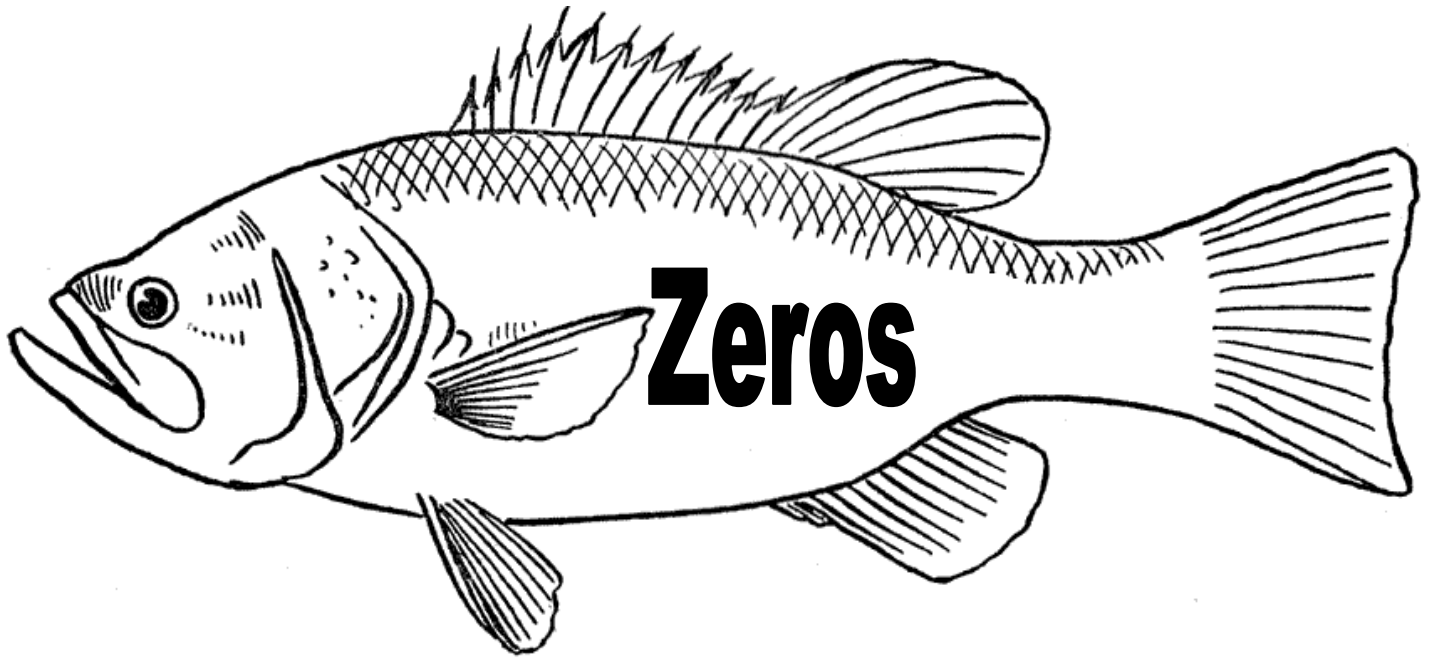
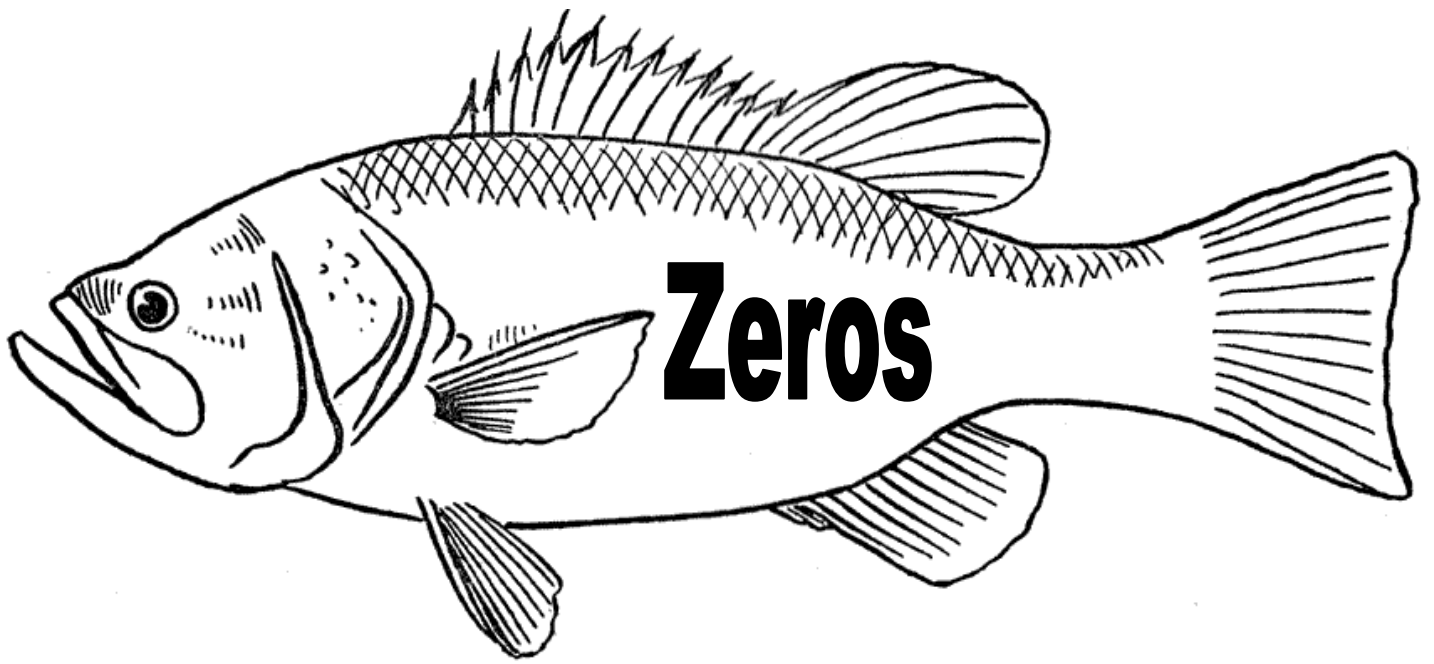
Students “catch a fish” for learning addition, subtraction, multiplication, or division facts.

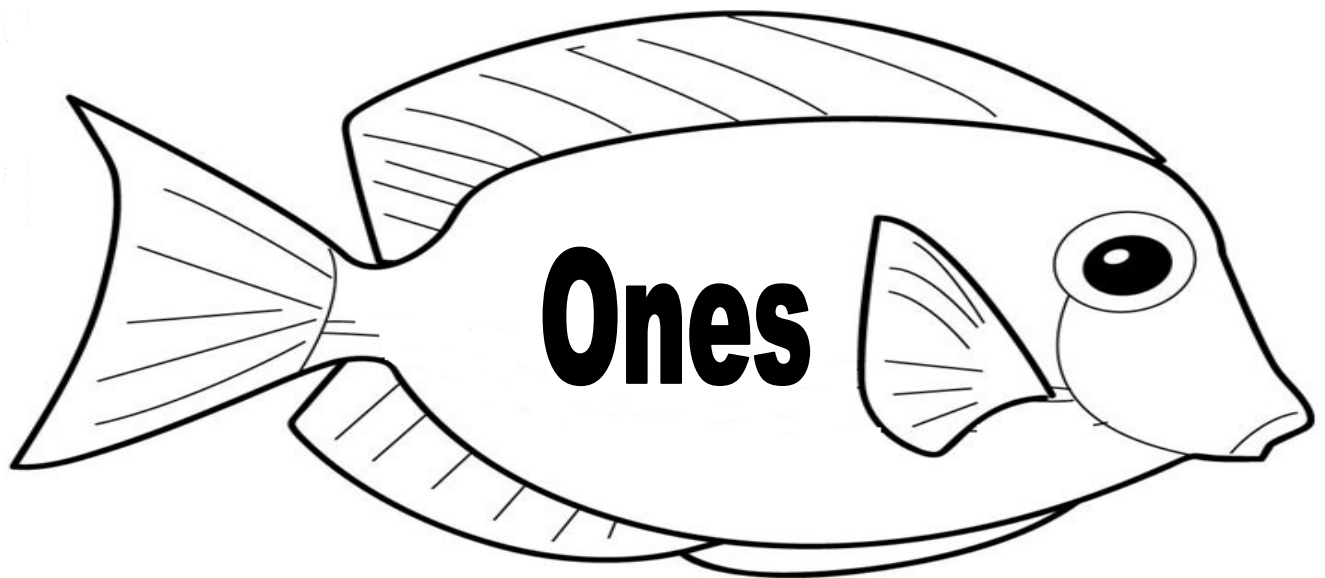
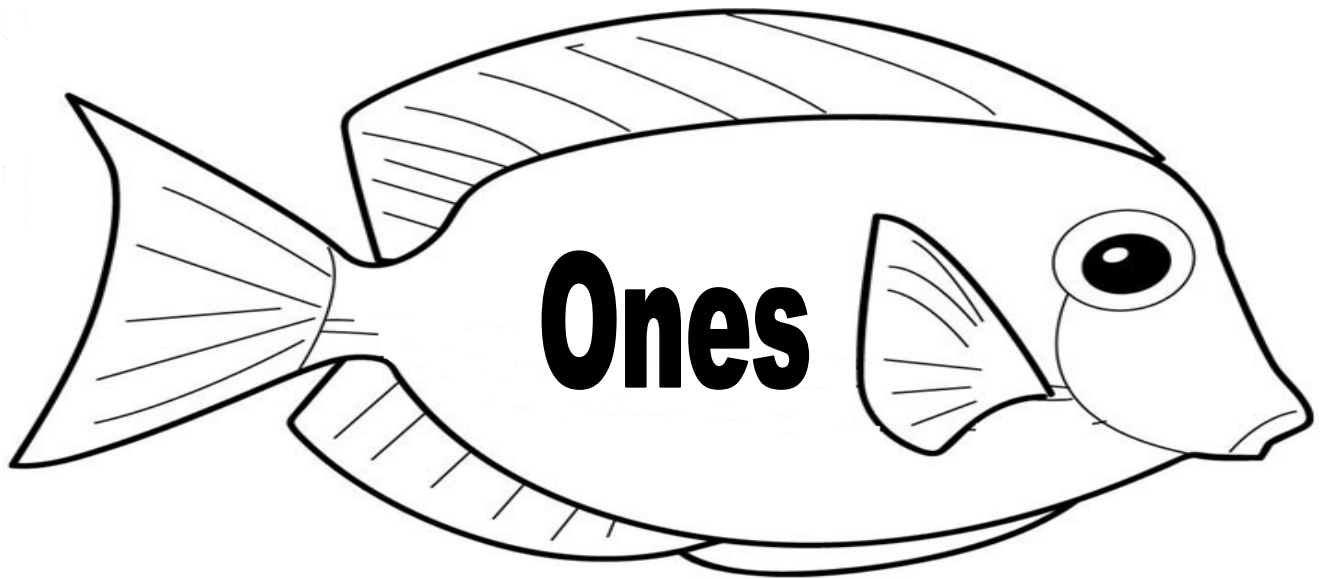
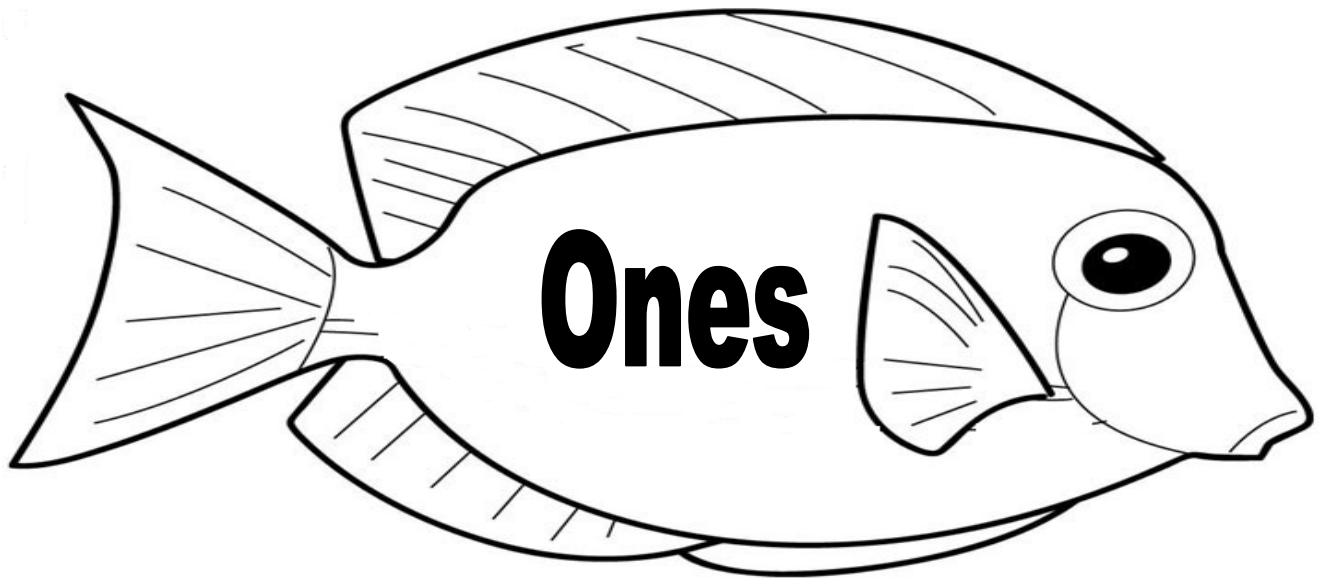
DIRECTIONS:

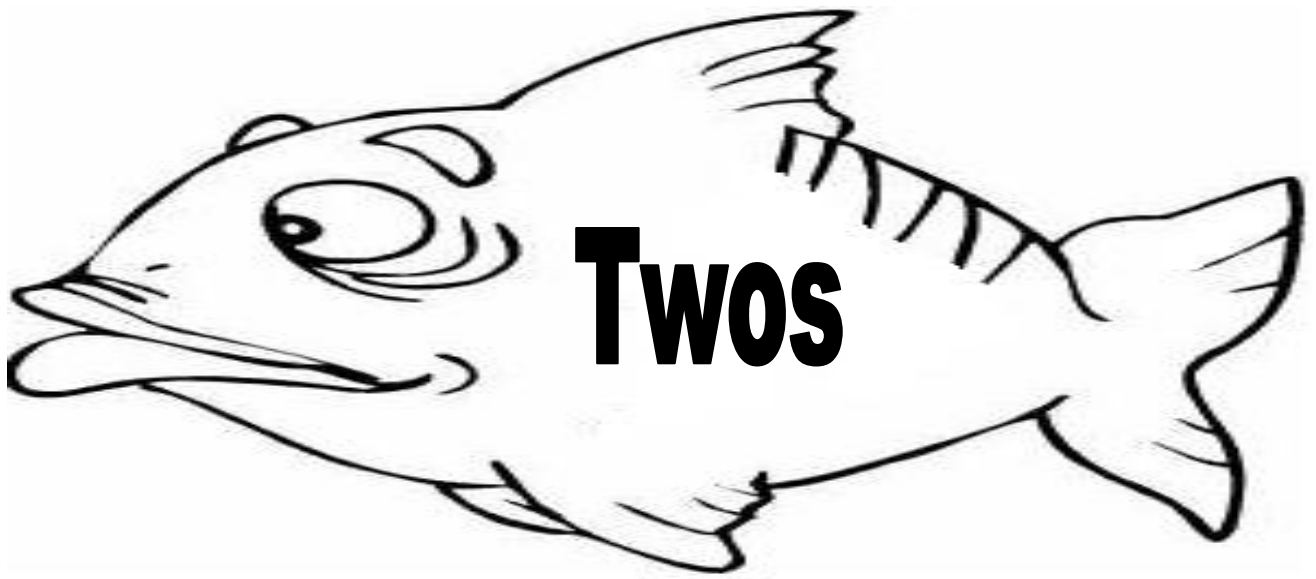
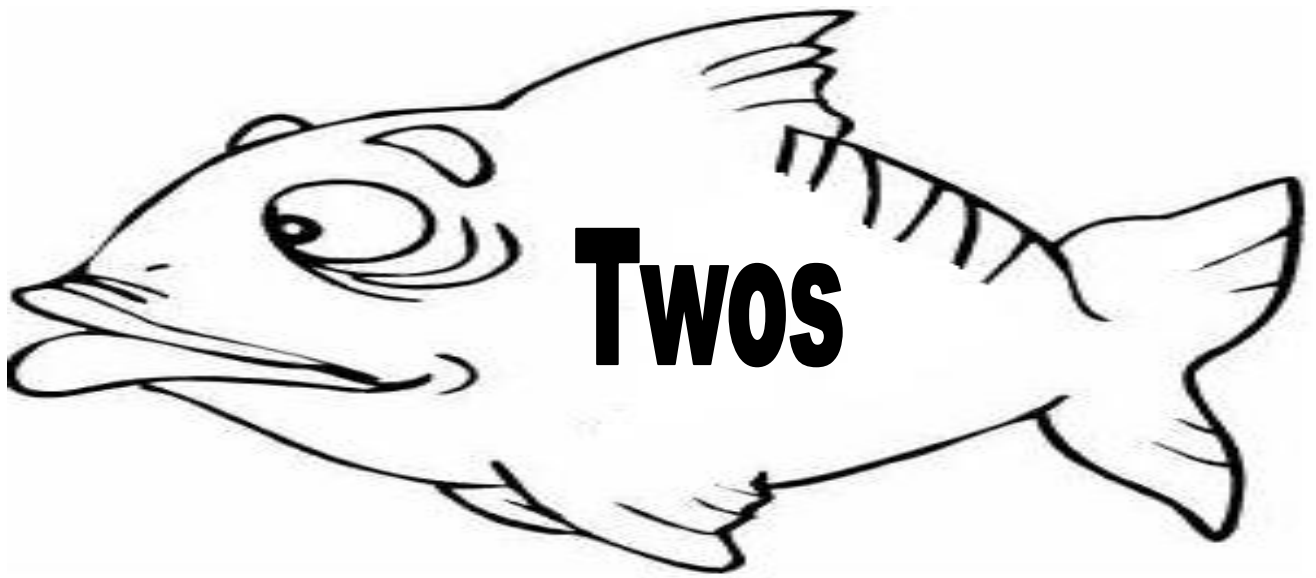
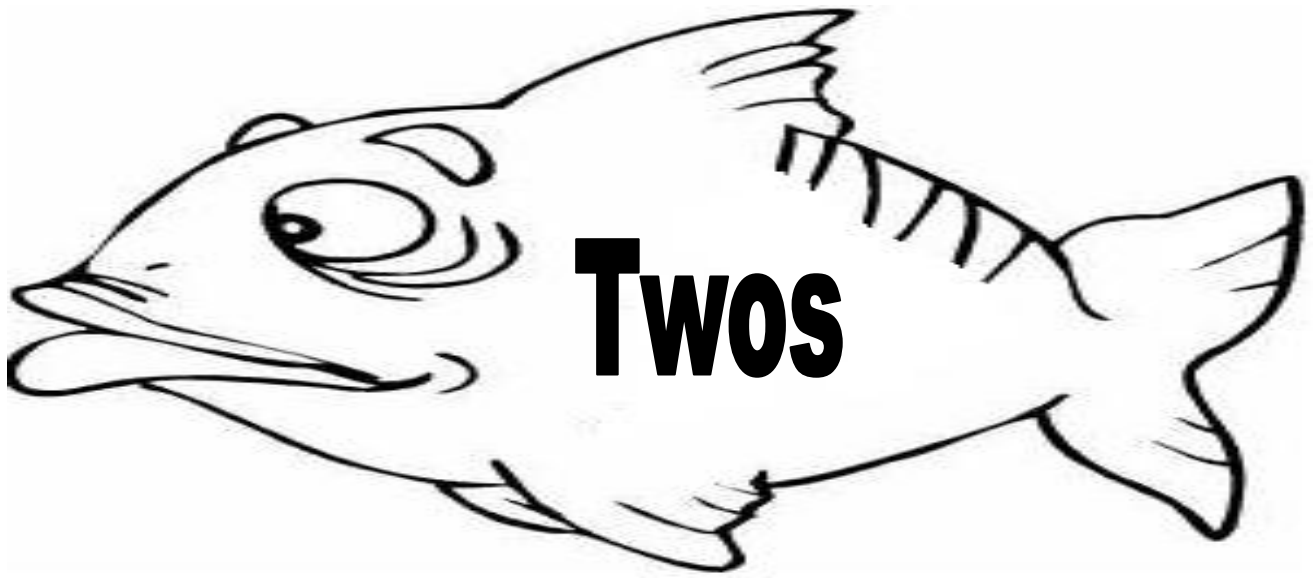
- Make copies of the fish pattern onto colorful paper (preferably cardstock). Each page should be a different color if possible.

- Once students show mastery of the “zeros” facts, they receive a fish to “hook” to their fishing line. Then students go onto their “ones” and so on.

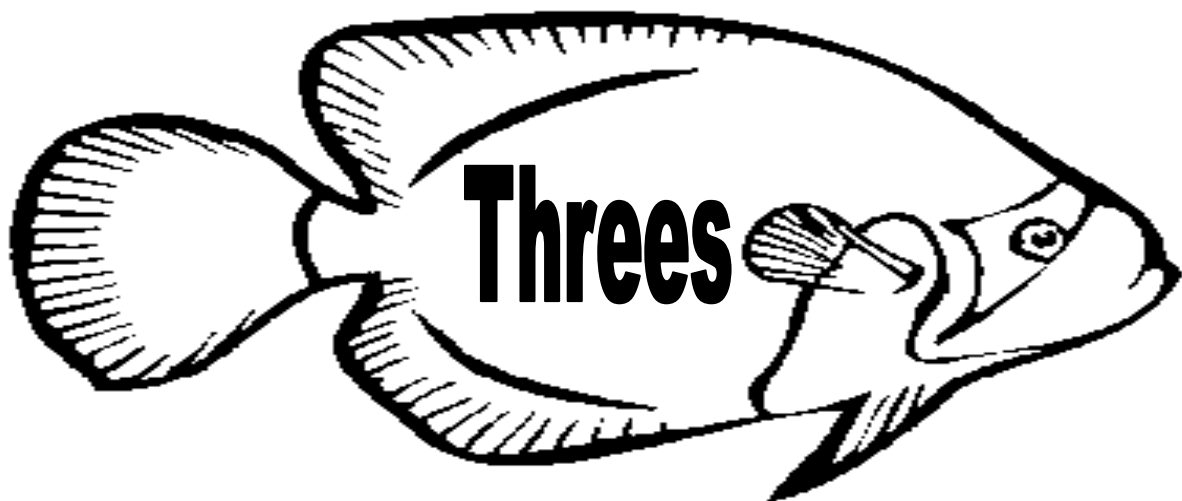
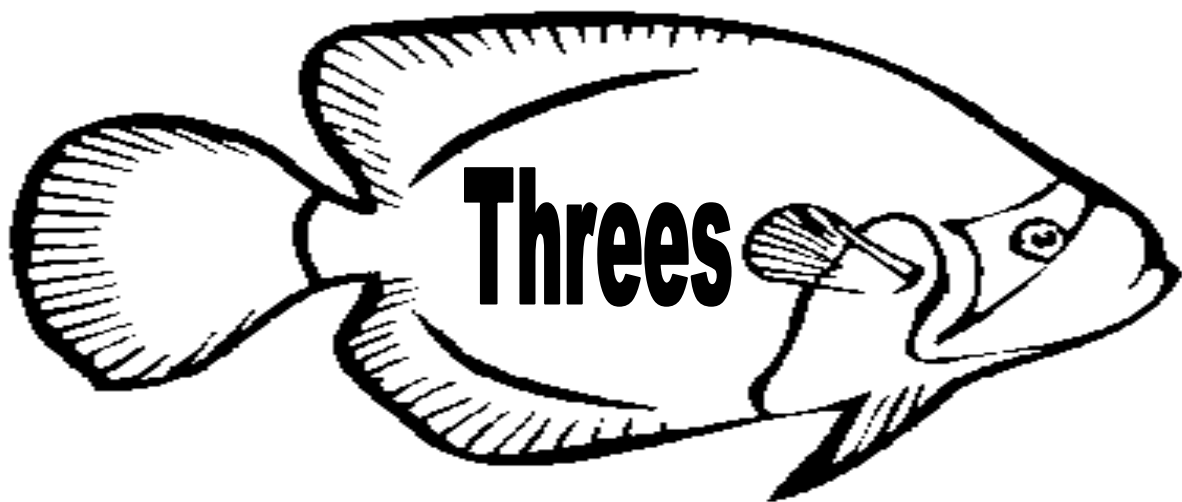
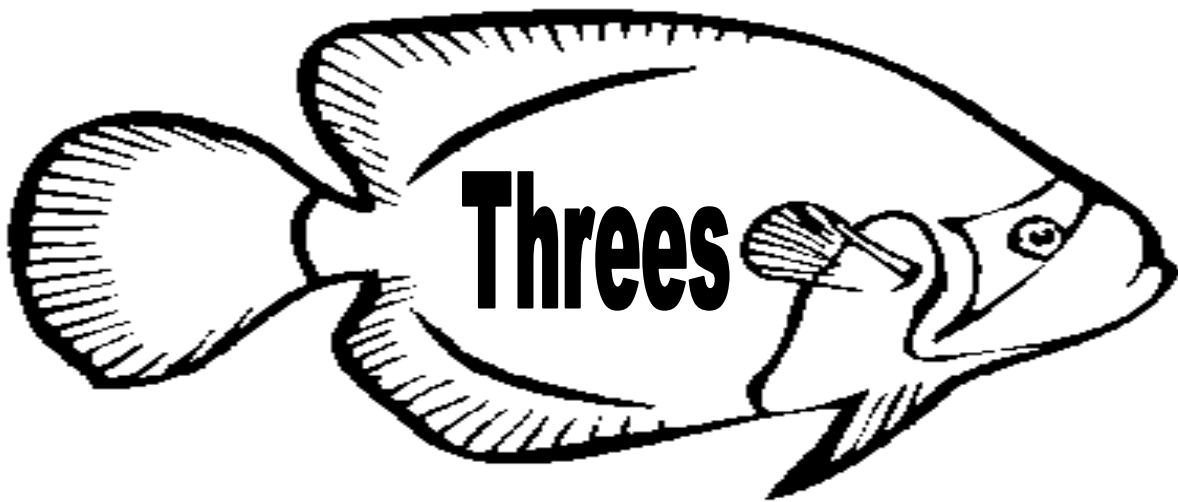


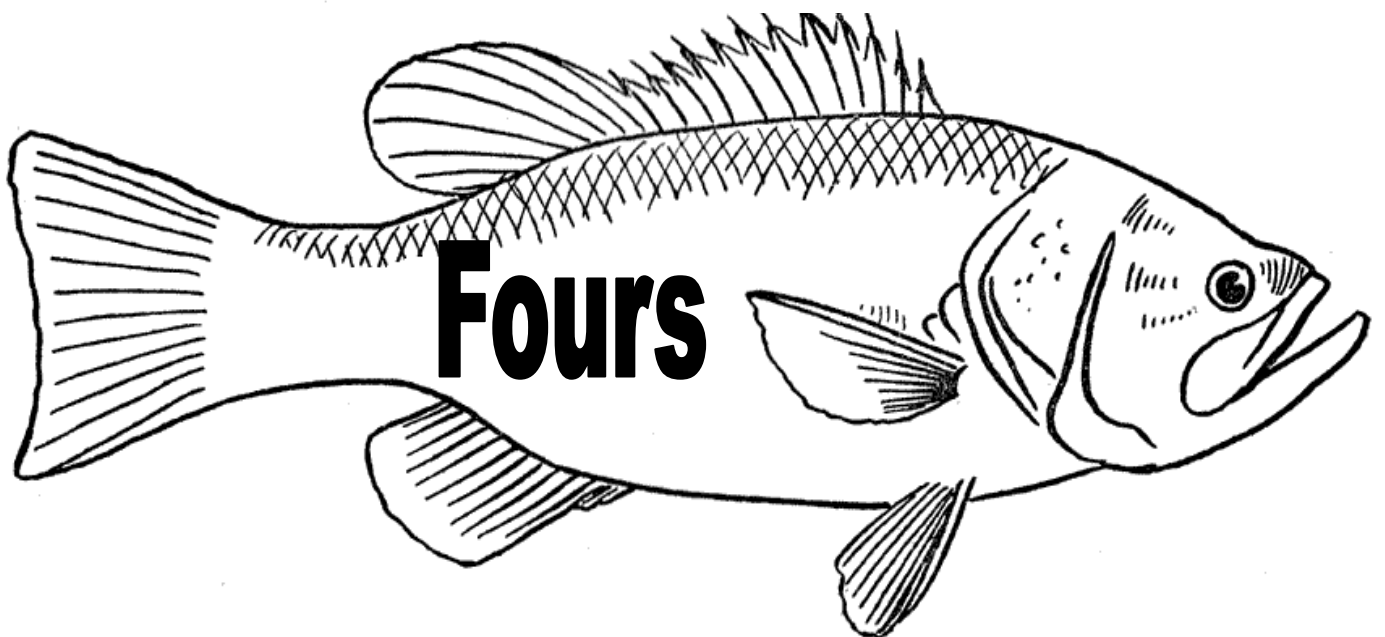
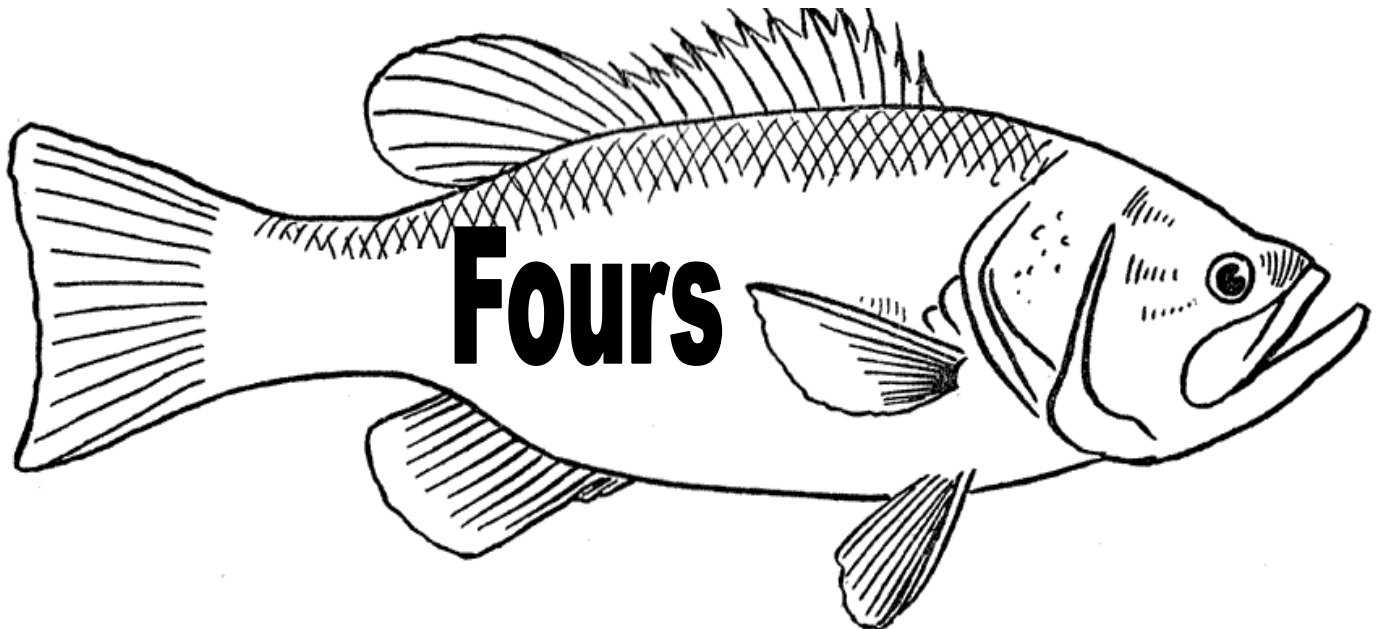
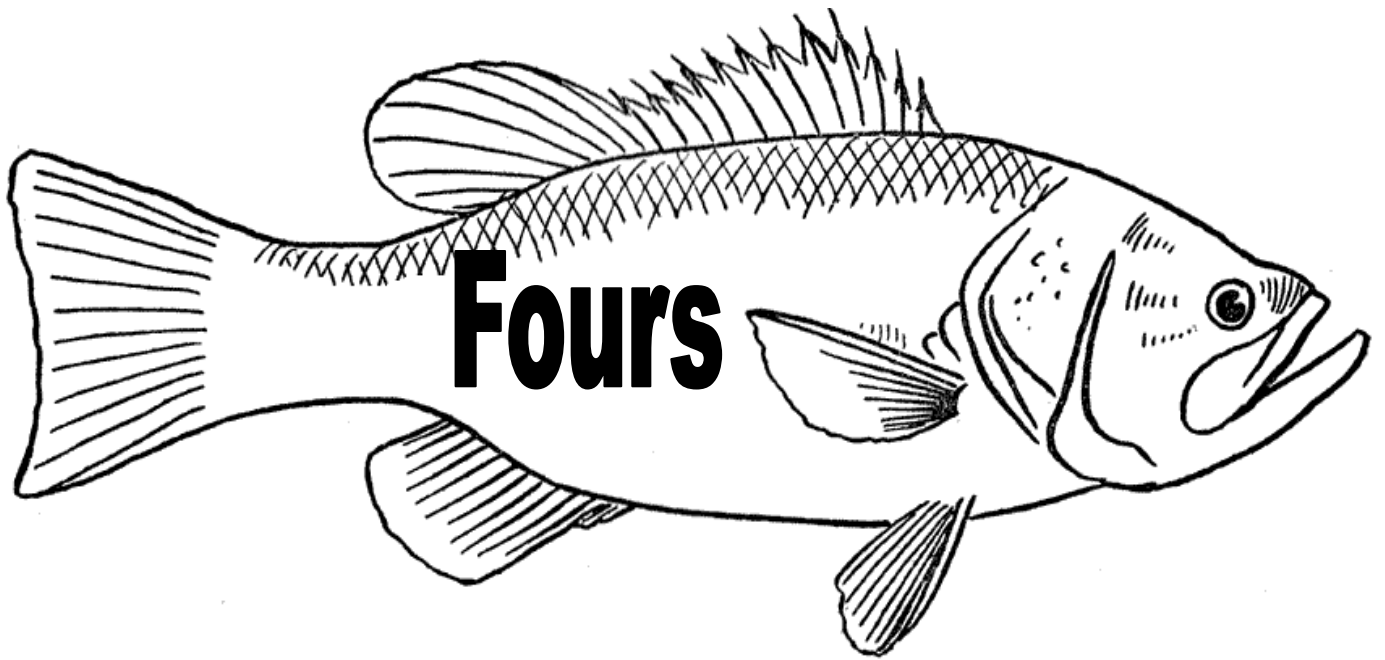


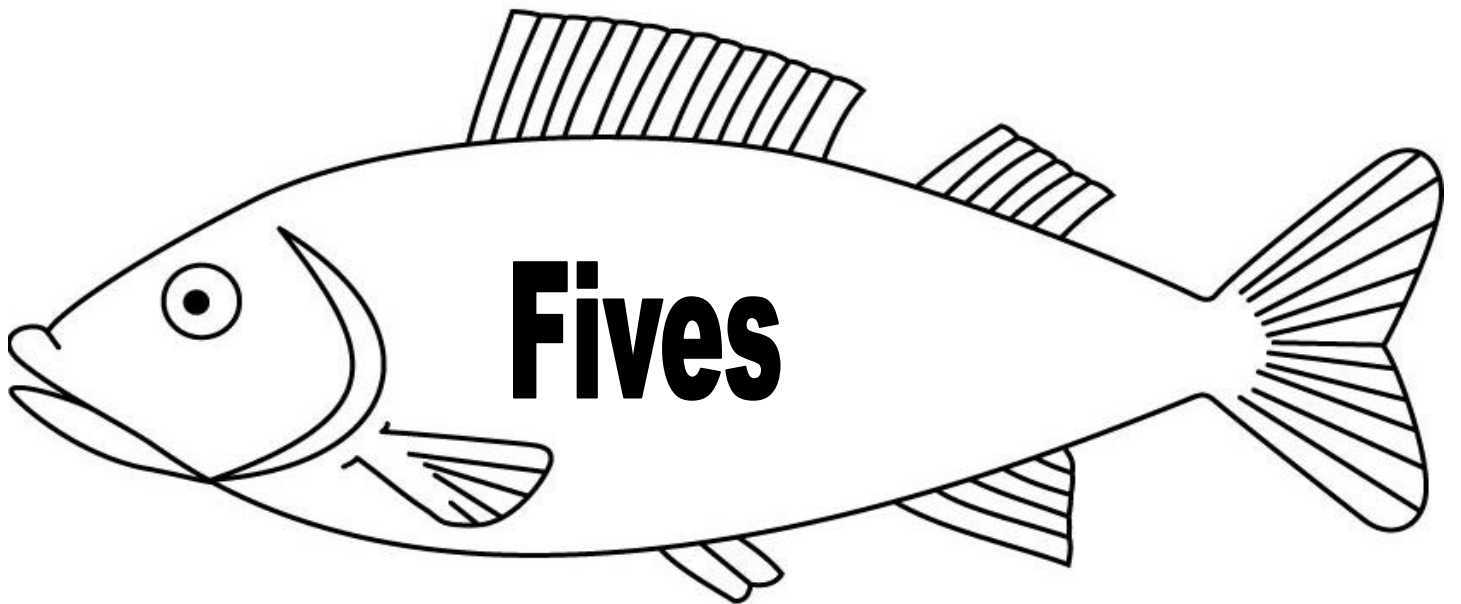
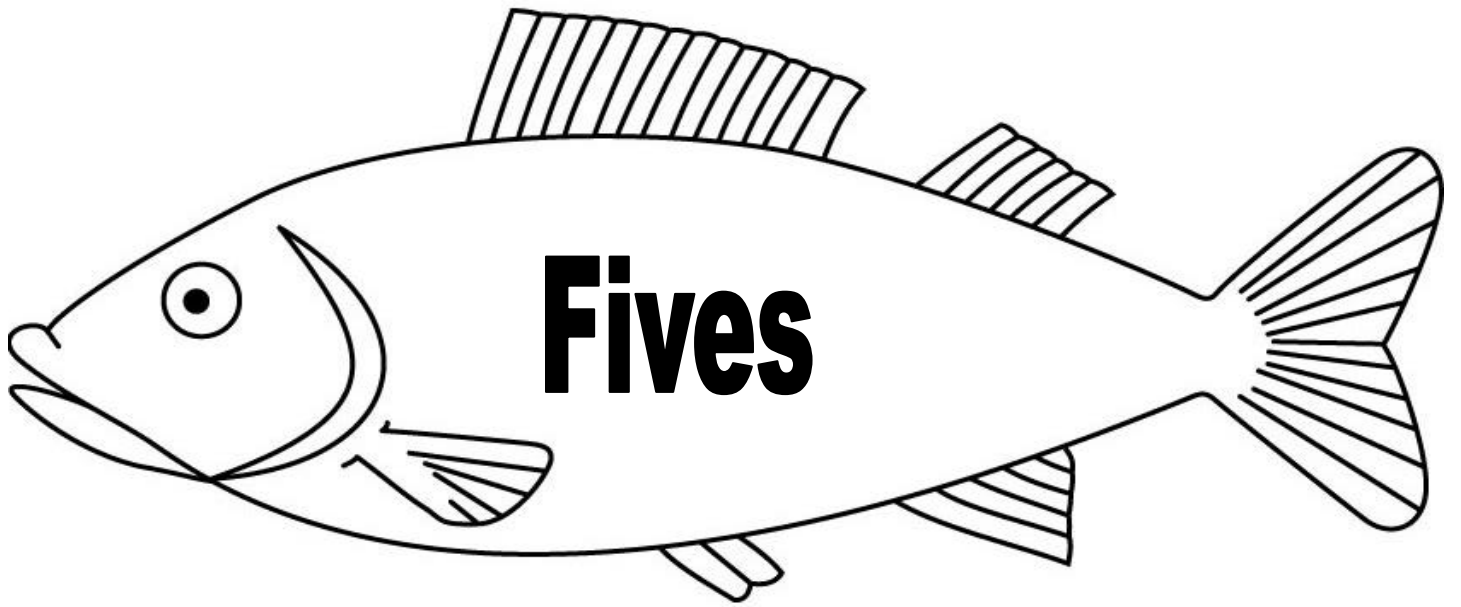
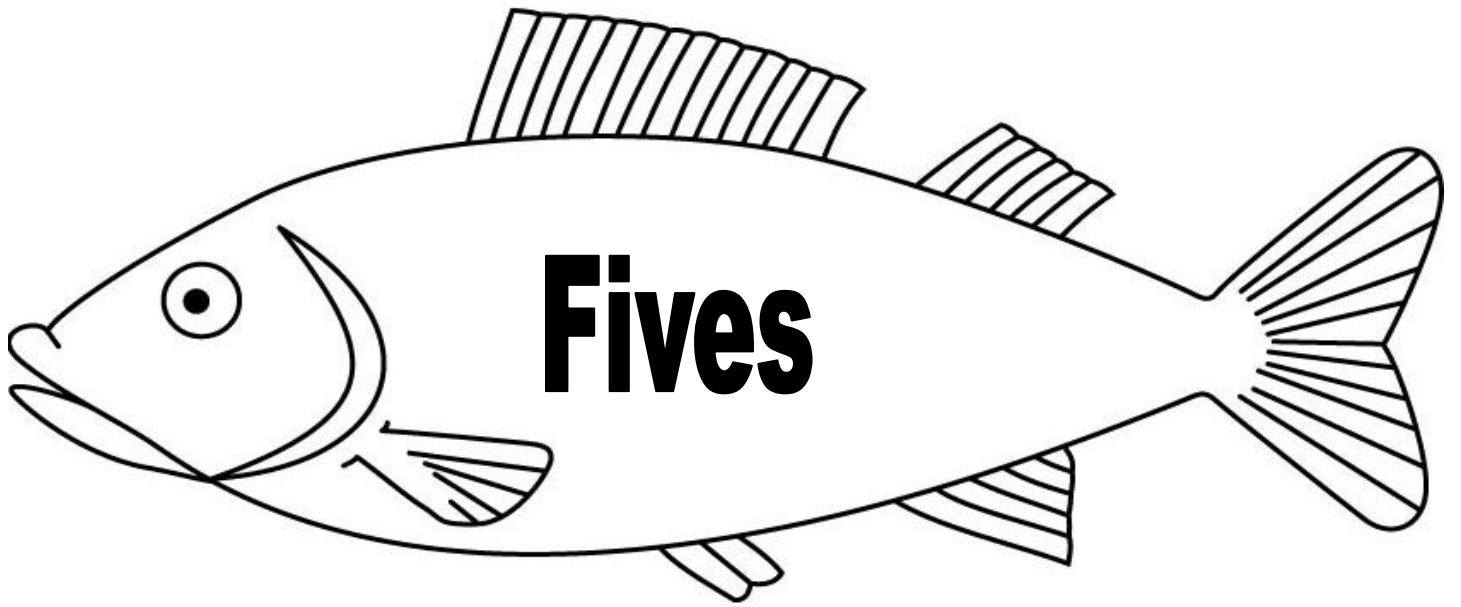


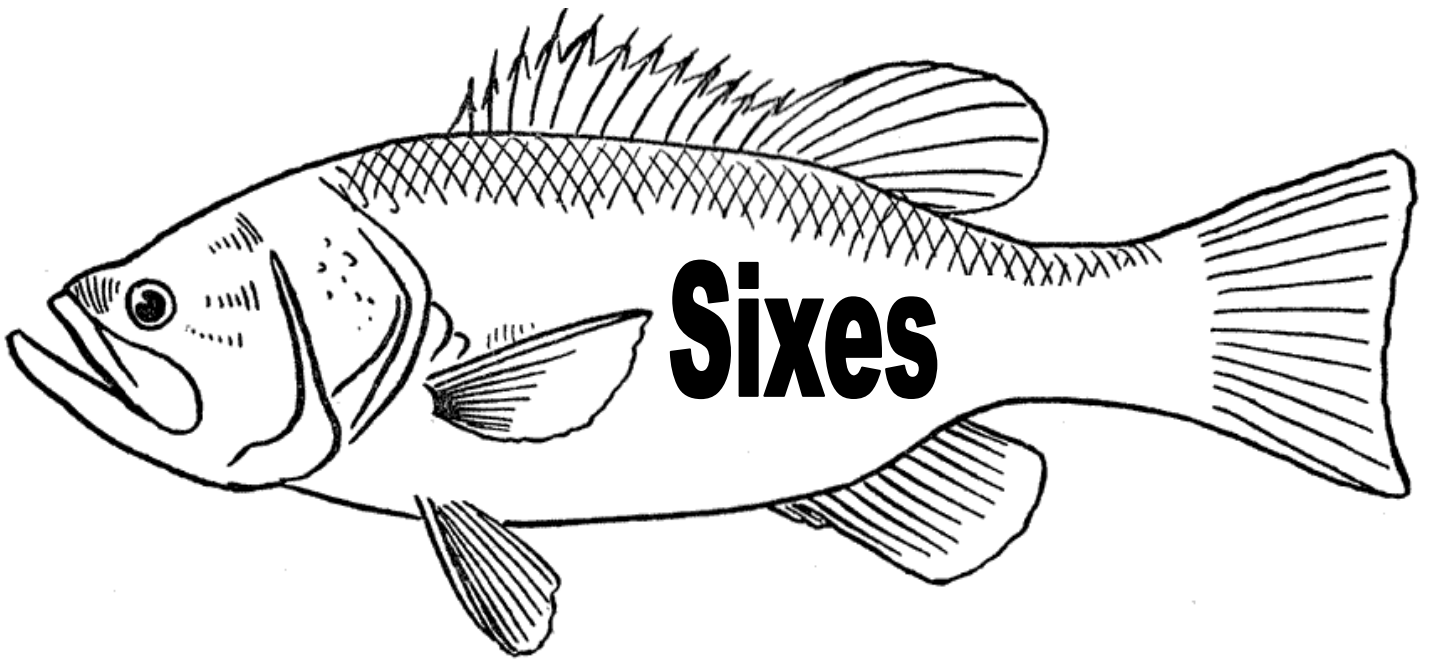




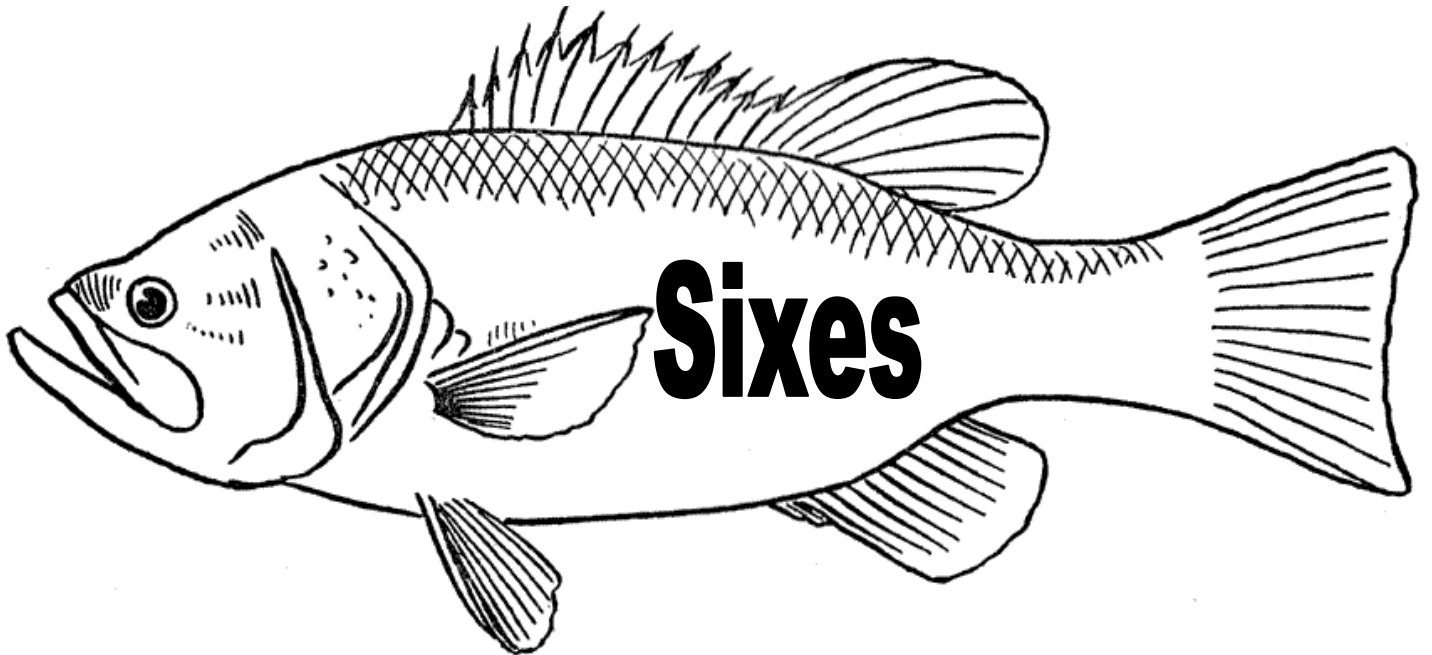




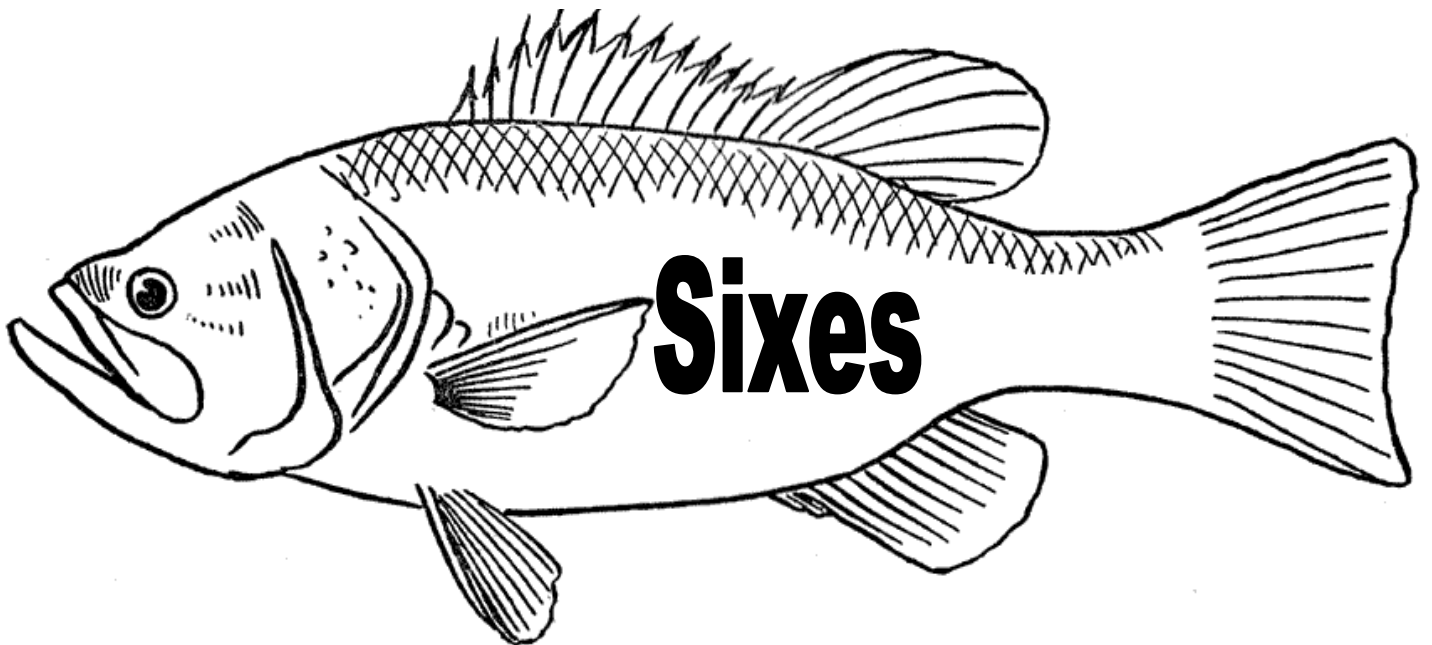
