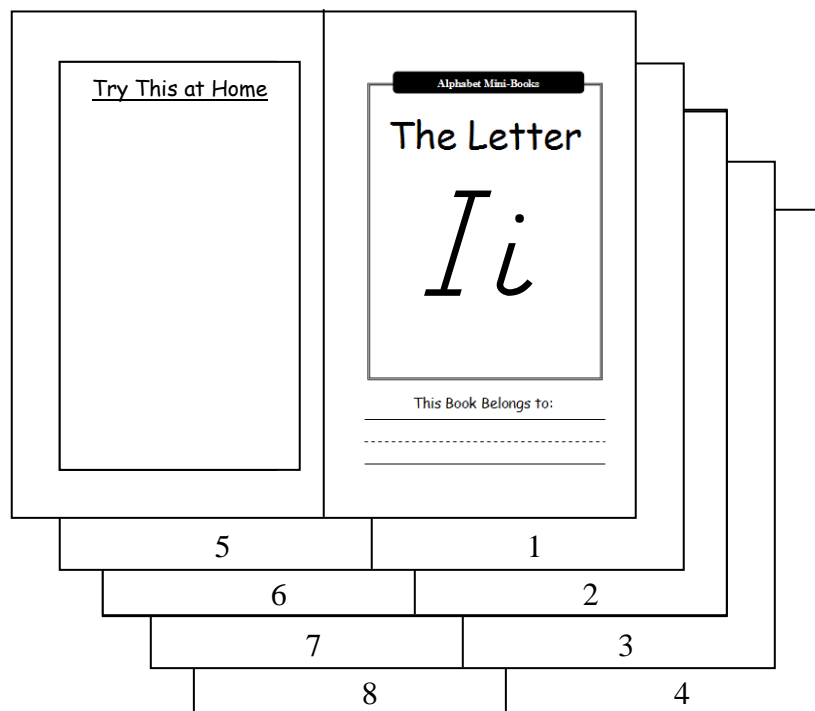


# Alphabet Mini-Books Assembly Instructions

1. Print a collated copy of the alphabet mini-book for each student (Figure A).

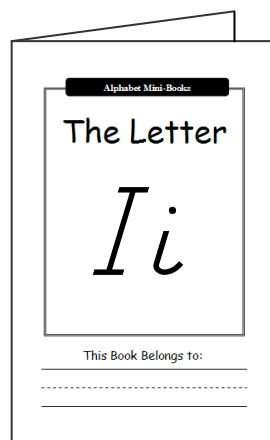
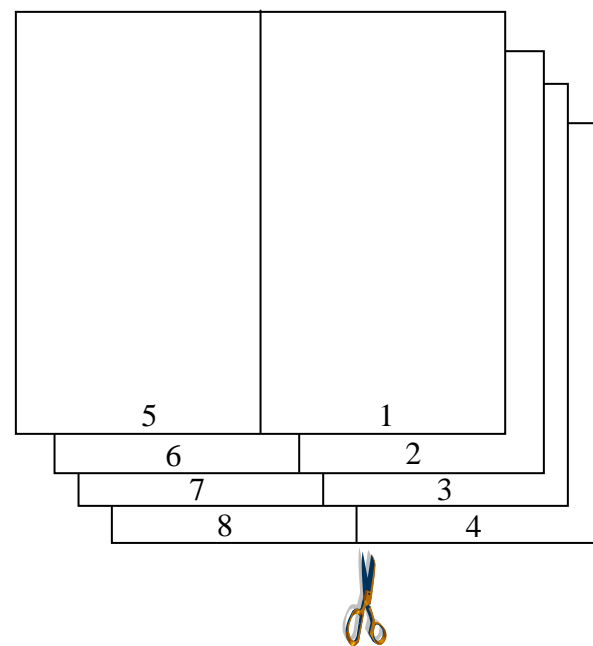

2. Fold the cover on the dotted line (Figure B).
3. Stack the other four pages on top of each other and cut on the solid black line. (Figure C).
4. Put the pages in order, and staple them inside the cover.

## Try This at Home

1. Finish coloring your Alphabet Mini-Book.
2. Cut out pictures from a magazine that begin with the letter "Ii." Glue the pictures to a piece of paper to make a collage.
3. Glue sand to the letters on page 1. Let it dry. Then practice tracing the letter "Ii" with your finger.
4. Practice writing the letter "Ii" on page 4.
5. Find and circle all the words that begin with the letter "Ii" in this book.
6. Read your Alphabet Mini-Book aloud to an adult.
7. Practice writing the letter "Ii" in shaving cream.
8. Practice writing the letter "Ii" in a tray of salt.
9. Make the letter "Ii" out of playdough.
10. Write the letter "Ii" on a blank piece of paper. Glue one inch squares of paper on the letter "Ii."
11. Use water and a paintbrush to "paint" the letter "Ii" outside on the concrete.

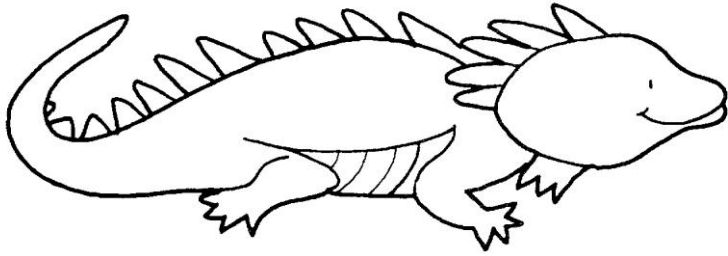
**Directions:** Cut out the pictures on the solid black lines. Glue the two pictures that *begin* with the letter “Ii” in the spots below.

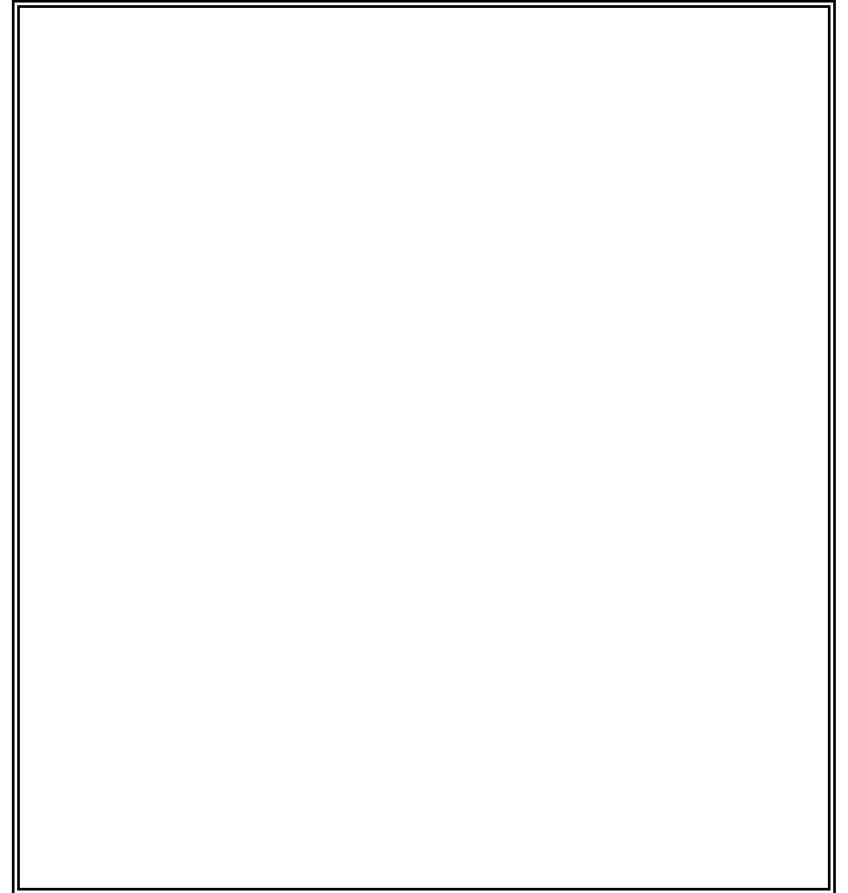

# Alphabet Recipe



is for Ice Cream

- 2 tablespoons sugar
- 1 cup milk or half & half
- $\frac{1}{2}$  teaspoon vanilla
- 12 tablespoons rock salt
- 1 pint-size zipper bag
- 1 gallon-size zipper bag
- ice cubes
  
- Put the milk, vanilla, and sugar into the small zipper bag. Seal the bag.
  
- Fill the gallon-size bag about  $\frac{1}{2}$  full with ice. Add the rock salt. Slip the pint size bag into the gallon size bag. Seal the gallon size bag.
  
- Shake for about 8 minutes until it turns to cream.
